

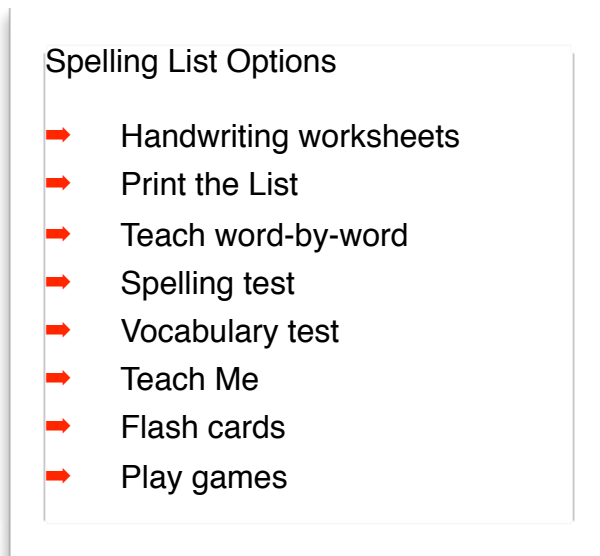
## SpellingCity

Learning spelling in any language requires memorization. Spelling City, found at [www.spellingcity.com](http://www.spellingcity.com), works on pronunciation and spelling (free, requires registration). It is designed for native speakers, but is entirely suitable for second language learners. After signing in to your account, one may enter a word list as a batch file, (all of the words at one time) This automatically generates 12 different exercises! These activities can be taken on the computer or adapted for the traditional classroom setting.

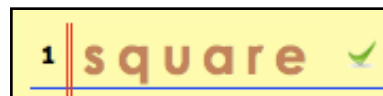


### Activity: Learning a spelling list with SpellingCity

1. Surf to [www.spellingcity.com](http://www.spellingcity.com)
2. Click on a **Featured Spelling Lists**
  - for example **Shapes**
  - The screen below appears

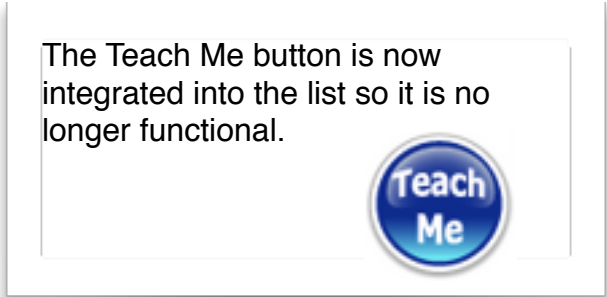


3. Look at the word list (only 8 items)
4. Click on the first item on the list "Square"
5. Listen and watch

- 4.Click “TeachMe Word-by-Word”

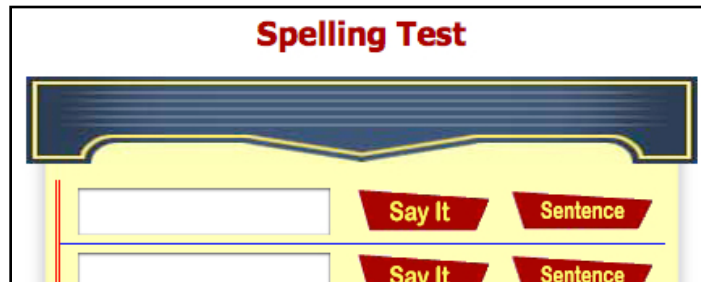

**Activity: Taking a spelling test with SpellingCity**

- 7.Click the “Spelling Test” button
- a welcome screen appears
- 8.Listen or click on “Say It”
- 9.Click on Sentence and listen
- 10.Click in the empty text box
- 11.Type the word (example: r-e-d)
- 12.Finish the test (make 1 error)
- 13.Click on the “Check Me” button
- 14.Results appear as below
- 15.Type a name in the “Speller’s Name:” textbox
